1. National Contact Points (NCP's)

NCP's: FP7-specific support structure

- Inform & assist people free of charge with FP7
- "Intermediary" between EC & FP7 participants
- Thematic responsibility
- In every member state, all associated states and in some third countries

- Network funded by the European Commission
- Local implantation
- Free information and support services
- Promote competitiveness and innovation in the internal European market
- Focus on SMEs, but also open to other businesses, universities, associations, etc.


A network in 40 countries!

- 4. Identification of suitable research, innovation and/or business partners:

 - → Pro-active approach: company's own profile
 - → Re-active approach: free e-mail alert service

EEB: services (2)

Supported partnerships:

- Technical Cooperation Agreements
- Joint Ventures
- Licensing & Manufacturing Agreements
- Commercial Agreements with Technical assistance
- Trade intermediary services (distributor, supplier, etc.)
- Franchise
- Subcontracting / Outsourcing activities...

Some examples: Technology offer

Water, slurry and soil pollution treatment by targeted use of bio-fixed bacteria (Ref: 09 BE 0213 3D2C)

Abstract: A Brussels-based SME has developed a quick and simple process that embeds bacteria in granules, which allows much more efficient degradation of almost all organic pollutants in water, slurry and soil, without requiring any other equipments. The company has strong references mainly in Belgium, Italy, the Netherlands and China, and looks for SME partners in the framework of commercial agreements with technical assistance.

Some examples: Technology request

Low cost system to process waste whey from cheese production – urgently needed (Ref: 09 GB 46P4 3CPJ)

Abstract: A manufacturer of a small range of cheese products in Scotland has issues in dealing with its waste whey. The company urgently need to find a low cost system to process this waste, or ideally convert it into its constituent parts for use in the food industry, perhaps by a partner company.
